SUMMER CAMP (2024) DRESS CODE

IMPORTANT- Sick Child: If your child, or any family member has any cold-like symptoms; Fever, cough, runny nose, headache, or have been exposed to any one with COVID-19, for the health and safety of your child and that of other children, servants, and the church, please **STAY HOME**, and notify the church. This is very serious, and it is an honest way of not spreading viruses or illnesses to others that may not be able to handle it. Your Child will not be allowed back before 10 days and the church's approval.

- Date: June 24th August 1st, Mondays, Wednesdays & Fridays 9:00 5:00
- FEE: \$150.00, (Plus \$20 for book & t-shirt).
- **Deadline** to register and pay is **May 26th**, **2024**. (NO late registration will be accepted).
- First Day, unless you signed ALL required paperwork, child MUST be dropped off by either parent to wait and sign the forms.
- **Parents:** Cannot stay behind, must drop off your child, and return for pick up at 5:00 P.M, no parents are to stay around, unless they are on the schedule to serve for that day.
- **FOOD** will be provided at church, EXCEPT on field trip days.

All attendees are to follow the church's dress code and grooming guidelines as follows:

- Liturgy Days: No shorts, but you can bring a change of clothes to change into.
- Appearance should be neat and acceptable with basic grooming, combed hair, and brushed teeth.



- Clothing and jewelry shall be free of writing, pictures, and any other insignia or indications which are profane or obscene. No short shorts/skirts. Girls wearing dresses or skirts must wear shorts or pants underneath. No Jewelry
- Electronic Devices; phones, tablets, iwatches,...etc. are not allowed at camp, and will be collected upon arrival. The church, servants and volunteers will NOT be responsible for any lost or damaged items. Please keep it at home, in case of an emergency, we will contact you, and you can call your child through a servant's phone, only in an emergency.
- Text Messages We may be sending you reminders of field trips via text messages, let us know if you cannot accept texts OR if you prefer paper reminder!
- **Pre-K & Kindergarten Parents:** Please send a mat for your child to use for napping, we do not have any at church. Your child should be potty trained.
- $3^{rd} 8^{th}$ Grade: Please send one item requiring simple sewing/alteration.
- **Pick Up:** Please DO NOT pick up your child without notifying a servant. Pick up is 5:00 Sharp.
- Field Trips: The children WILL NOT be permitted to purchase any food, drink or gifts on any of the field trips, uncles otherwise announced in advance.
- Pre-Servants and Volunteers Are not to hold or use their phone at anytime during camp. If you must use your phone, notify the lead class servant, and use it privately out of sight.
- No Chewing gum at anytime at the church property.

*ALL CHILDREN NOT ABIDING BY THE DRESS CODE AND RULES WILL BE SEND HOME TO BE PROPERLY PREPARED FOR CHURCH.
