***** Happiness is a divine commandment

"Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!" (Phil 4:4)

"Rejoice always." (1 Thes 5:16)

We may ask, "How we are asked to be happy? Is it in our hands?"

❖ God is the Source of happiness, and His Church is a community of joy

"Oh, taste and see that the Lord is sweet; blessed is the man who trusts in Him!" (Ps 34:8)

"Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people He has chosen as His own inheritance." (Ps 33:12)

"But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create; for behold, I create Jerusalem as a rejoicing, and her people a joy. I will rejoice in Jerusalem, and joy in My people; the voice of weeping shall no longer be heard in her, nor the voice of crying." (Isa 65:18-19)

"Happy are you, O Israel! Who is like you, a people saved by the Lord, the shield of your help and the sword of your majesty! Your enemies shall submit to you, and you shall tread down their high places." (Deut 33:29)

Blessed are the people who know the joyful sound! They walk, O LORD, in the light of Your countenance. In Your name they rejoice all day long, and in Your righteousness they are exalted. (Ps 89:15-16)

"Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready." (Rev 19:7)
