St Shenouda The Archimandrite

- He departed on Abib 7th.
- He was born in the district of Akhmim. His father entrusted him with the care of the sheep.
- His father took him to his uncle Anba Bgoul who predicted that he would be a father for many peoples.
- One day he heard a voice from heaven saying, "Shenouda has become the Archimandrite".
- When Anba Bgoul departed, Shenouda replaced him. He followed the monastic communal rules that were formulated by St Pakhom.
- The number of monks during his days reached 1800 monks in the monastery of Anba Bishoy (Souhag).
- He had built another monastery, the number of its monks reached 2200 monks.
- He became a shining light to all the world with his sermons, discourses and canons.
- He attended the Council of the two hundred that gathered at Ephesus with the holy father Anba Kyrillos (24th), and he admonished Nestorius the heretic.

- He departed on kiahk 8 th.

 He was born in the city of Dakluba, diocese of Masil, from holy parents.

 He went to the desert of Scete by the help of an angel, in the from of a monk.

- He lived with Abba Agathon for three years in total obedience in every way. After Abba Agathon's departure, he was ordained a priest over the church of St Macarius in Scete.
- He seized Leo's Tome (a letter aganist the Orthodox faith)
 and rent it into pieces. When the envoy saw this, he
 ordered him to be beaten with pins and one of
 these strikes enucleated one of his eyes. Then he was
 driven away from the monastery.

 The angel commanded him to dwell in El- Qualamon where he built his monastery.

- -He was tortured from the Barbars until the Virgin, St Mary, appeared to him and told him, "This place shall be my abode forever," and from that day the Barbarians never attacked this monastery again.
- When the time of his departure drew near he gathered together his sons and commanded them to be strong in the fear of God.
- Abba Samuel wrote many discourses and articles. He prophesied many matters about Egypt.

- He was martyred on Abib 24th.


 He was born in the city of Nehisa (district of Talkha). His parents were pure and merciful and they reared him in the fear of God.

- He was twelve years old, when Diocletian incited the persecution aganist the Christian.

- One day, he heard the priest teaching the believers, strengthening them in the faith and encouraging them to deliver themselves over to death for the sake of the Lord Christ.
- He returned to his house and gave all his money to the poor and needy, then went to Samanoud.
- He confessed the Name of the Lord Christ before Lucianus the governor who tortured him severely. Then he hung him up upon the mast of his ship head downwards. The angel of the Lord came down from heaven and wiped up the blood that was running down from his nose. Strong winds blew, that made the ship to sail fast to Athribes.-When they arrived, the soldiers confessed the Lord Christ and they received the crown of martyrdom.
- The governor of Athribis tortured St Abbanoub severely, then sent him to the city of Alexandria. He was tortured until he received the crown of martyrdom. His prayers be with us. Amen.

St Theodore El- Mishrek and St Theodore of Shotep

- St Theodore of Shotep was martyred on Abib 20th, 220 AD.

- His father's name was John and he was from the city of Shotep in Upper Egypt. But the Saint was born in the city of Antioch.

- He joined the army and advanced in the ranks until he became one of the great generals during the reign of Emperor Lucianus.

- He saved two sons of a widow from the great serpent of the city of Eukhitos.

 He confessed the Lord Christ before the Emperor. The Emperor ordered him beaten with rods, burned, and cast into the fire. He delivered up his soul and received the crown of martyrdom.

- The commemoration of the relocation of the body of St Theodore the prince, to the

city of Shotep, in the province of Assiut is on Hator 15th.

- St Theodore El- Mishreke (the Oriental) was martyred on Toba 12th, 306 AD.
- He was born in the city of Tyre in 270 AD.

- His father was a high ranking official.

- He enlisted in the Roman army and was promoted to the rank of commander.
- He saw a vision at night and knew that he would be martyred with Lawondius and Banikaros, the Persian.
- During a Trace, between the Roman and Persain armies, he met with Banikaros and guided him to Christianity.
- When Emperor Diocletian ordered them to worship the idols, they refused. He commanded his soldiers to nail St Theodore to a tree and to brutally torture him, until he delivered up his soul. Then he ordered to behead the rest of the soldiers. Their prayers be with us. Amen.



St Samaan, The Tanner.

- He was born in Babylon (Old Cairo) during the time of Pope Abram the Syrian.
- His profession was tanning animal skins, and also the crafts that depend on this process, such as shoemaking and the like.
- He simply carried out the commandment literally, when he drove the awl into one of his eyes, thus plucking it out, as he looked lustfully at a woman."If your right eye causes you to sin, gouge it and throw it away."(MT 5: 28).
- He was an ascetic person. He ministered to the older people and the sick, bringing them water every day.
- With his prayers, a great miracle happened which is the miracle of moving the Mokattam Mountain in Cairo.
- After the miracle had been performed, he disappeared.

 She gave birth to Mahrael in Tamouh and Abahour in Siriakos.
- As Mohrael grew up she lived an ascetic life.
- Mohrael was martyred in Unsena at the age of twelve with many other martyrs and confessors.

 Eulita was born in Iconium in Asia Minor to a Christain parents.

 She got married at a young age and she had only one son called him Kyriacos.
 Her husband passed away suddenly, and

she had to raise her son by herself.

 During the persecution of Diocletion, she took her son and fled to Tarsus.

 In Tarsus, the Roman ruler arrested her and her son, she confessed her faith and kyriacos started yelling, "I am Christian".

- The tetrarch got mad at this strange child, and he threw him with all his power to the ground.
 Kyriacos hit his head against one of the concrete steps, and died instantly, to receive the crown of martyrdom. He was only three years old.
- When Eulita saw her own son fall dead infront of her, she sighed with relief, since she was sure that he went to Jesus in Paradise. The ruler ordered her to be beheaded on Abib15th.
